Program Background:

Texas Medicaid is currently engaged in planning and developing the incentive payment program for the meaningful use of certified electronic health record (EHR) technology. Incentive payments to eligible professionals (EPs) and eligible hospitals (EHs) will be based on providers meeting certain eligibility and meaningful use criteria as defined in the final rules issued by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Eligible professionals for the Medicaid Incentive Program may include:

- Physicians
- Dentists
- Certified nurse midwives
- Nurse practitioners
- Physician assistants who are practicing in Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHCs) or Rural Health Clinics (RHCs) led by a physician assistant
